INDIGENOUS SCHOLARSHIP

Emmanuel College's Indigenous scholarship was created in 2008. It is a scholarship of part relief of fees awarded to a student of Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander background who has been accepted into any discipline at The University of Queensland.

The College's aim is to provide opportunities for outstanding Indigenous students to live within a residential college community where there is pastoral care, academic support and the opportunity to network. It is expected that the student will act as an ambassador for the College.

The scholarship is renewable on the student continuing to achieve at a high level academically and making a positive contribution to the life of the College.

Selection for the scholarship will be made in consultation with The University of Queensland's Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Studies Unit.
