



EMMANUEL COLLEGE INFORMATION SHEET FOR SCHOLARSHIPS AND BURSARIES

CONDITIONS

The College offers a number of scholarships and bursaries funded through philanthropy and gifts from donors and benefactors, who in many cases are alumni.

- **Scholarships** are awarded on the **basis of academic merit** (minimum requirement is that your GPA is likely to qualify for Honours). The continuance of a scholarship from semester to semester depends on the scholarship holder maintaining high academic achievement.
- **Bursaries** are awarded on the **basis of need**. The College requires evidence of financial hardship from an applicant seeking a bursary.
- Both **scholarships and bursaries** are offered as a remission in College fees rather than as a cash payment. The remission shall be applied across both semesters.
- **Scholarships and bursaries** are normally awarded on an annual basis to cover one full academic year.
- Applicants may apply for a scholarship or bursary or, if they wish, they may apply for consideration in **both categories** – scholarship and bursary.

Scholarships include:

- **The Dr Diana Cavaye Scholarship** for academic excellence and service to others.
- **The Sir Harry Gibbs' Law Scholarship** for a student studying law at The University of Queensland in second year or above who is achieving outstanding results and has a desire to make a positive contribution to the life of the College.
- **Emmanuel College Scholarships** - Emmanuel College will give an unconditional offer of a place to any student awarded a University of Queensland Excellence or Merit Scholarship. Emmanuel Scholarships will be awarded on a competitive basis and at the Principal's discretion. Please note, there is no information sheet for these scholarships.
- **The Principal's Entrance Scholarship** for an outstanding student in their first year at Emmanuel who is likely to make a valuable contribution to the life of the College. Please note, there is no information sheet for this scholarship.
- **Indigenous Scholarship/s** for students of Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander background who demonstrate high academic achievement and the desire to make a positive contribution to the life of the College.
- **Rugby Scholarship/s** for students who have been accepted into any discipline at The University of Queensland, show sound academic ability, a significant talent for rugby and have the desire to make a positive contribution.

Applications for **scholarships** within Emmanuel College will be assessed on the following:

- General statement in support of your application.
- Copy of UQ academic transcript and evidence of UQ prizes, Dean's List etc, as appropriate.
- Your year and cumulative GPA (estimated for first year students).
- Study/course statement (500–700 words) explaining your interest in your field of study; and the application of your degree program in your future.
- College life statement (500–700 words) explaining what living at Emmanuel College would mean/means to you and why you are seeking to continue with your College membership (*if applicable*).
- Full CV.
- Two personal references.

In the case of students already enrolled at The University of Queensland, a decision regarding the outcome of your application will be made once GPA results are released.
