Emmanuel College Scholarship #2	New applicant	Unconditional offer of a place to any student awarded a UQ Vice-Chancellor, Excellence or Merit Scholarship (subject to room availability).	Part relief of fees
Dr Diana Cavaye Scholarship	New applicant in third year or above at UQ (including post graduate students). Existing resident with significant period of residence (including post graduate students).	Created in 2006 by the family of Dr Diana Cavaye, a dedicated supporter and Honorary Fellow of Emmanuel College, and awarded for academic excellence and service to others. The scholarship may be used for any scholarly purpose including fees, travel, attendance at a conference, and accommodation or research expenses. Within one month after the termination of the scholarship, the Diana Cavaye Scholar must submit a report to the Principal on all activities undertaken during tenure of the scholarship and, if appropriate, address the College residents describing the advantages of the scholarship. The report is to be made available to the students and in due course deposited with the directors who will maintain an archive of the reports. It is expected that the recipient will act as an ambassador for the College. This scholarship is renewable from year to year depending upon the recipient maintaining the requirements of the scholarship.</p> <p>Scholarship recipients are expected to correspond with their benefactors at least twice a year.</p> <p>more information</p>	Part relief of fees (up to 50%)
Rugby Scholarship	New applicant or existing resident	<p>For students who have been accepted into any discipline at The University of Queensland, show sound academic ability, a significant talent for rugby and have the desire to make a positive contribution to the life of the College.</p> <p>Scholarship applicants may be eligible for a joint Emmanuel College and UQ Rugby Football Club (UQRFC) scholarship where the successful recipient will be given the opportunity to take up a full scholarship in the UQ Rugby Academy (UQRA) for the calendar year. The UQRA allows players to train in a professional environment, which includes skill sessions, specialised strength and conditioning program, speed and agility sessions, and much more. Evans Family Scholarship	New applicant	<p>Created in 2009, this scholarship encourages high school level students participating in sport at an elite level (State or National level) to continue to pursue their sporting goals while simultaneously beginning their tertiary education.</p> <p>Preference will be given to students who may not have otherwise been able to consider attending university due to the financial hurdle involved in doing so. In considering applications, the existing financial position of the student and the amount of time required to train for the sport they are participating in will be taken into account.</p> <p>The scholarship is renewable for a second year dependent on the student continuing to achieve at a high level and making a positive contribution to the life of the College.</p> <p>Scholarship recipients are expected to correspond with their benefactors at least twice a year.</p> <p>more information</p>	Part relief of fees (up to 50%) capped for two years for any one recipient
<p>Lucy Morris Stevens Scholarship</p> <p>The scholarship is named after the late Lucy Morris Stevens and is provided by a bequest from her husband, the late Mr James McMillan Dunn Stevens. Mr Stevens stipulated that the award be: "In memory of Lucy Morris Stevens who wrote and produced plays and pageants for girls and women in Brisbane between 1929 and 1965, bequeathed by her husband James McMillan Stevens a former Chairman of the Council of Emmanuel College."</p>	New applicant or existing resident studying Drama/Theatre/Performance or English at UQ in second year or above (including post graduate students).	<p>Created in 2010 and awarded to a student achieving outstanding results and the desire to make a positive contribution to the life of the College. The scholarship will be renewable on the recipient continuing to achieve at a high level academically, playing with the Emmanuel College Highlanders and contributing to the life of the College. The successful recipient will also commit to playing regularly with the Band.</p> <p>more information</p>	Part relief of fees (up to \$4,000)
Travelling Scholarship	New applicant or existing resident	<p>Created in 2012 in conjunction with The Society of St Andrew of Scotland (Queensland) Limited and awarded to a student who has been accepted into any discipline at The University of Queensland who shows sound academic ability and who intends to study abroad, in any discipline, at either The University of Edinburgh or The University of Glasgow, both of which are Universitas 21 (a global network of research universities) partners with UQ. If academic performance is sound, the scholarship recipient will be assured of a place on their return to Emmanuel College.</p> <p>As a resident of Emmanuel College, the student must secure a place at The University of Edinburgh or The University of Glasgow as a study abroad exchange student from UQ. They must apply to the Principal of Emmanuel College with an essay of 750 – 1,000 words as to why they want to study at The University of Edinburgh or The University of Glasgow. On their return from study abroad, they will provide a report to the College and The Society of St Andrew of Scotland (Queensland) Limited.</p> <p>more information</p>	\$4,000

Mark McKay Scholarship	Existing resident studying law	<p>Established by Dr Brian Maher and created in 2011 this scholarship is awarded in memory of Mr Mark McKay who spent five years at Emmanuel from 1974-1979.</p> <p>A Students' Club President and Collegian of the Year, Mark was killed in a car accident in 1988. He was a practising solicitor in Mackay, his home town, where he was on the board of Lifeline, a committee member of the Marriage Guidance Council and was the local branch President of the Liberal Party. He instituted the first law week in Mackay, where free legal advice booths were provided to the public.</p> <p>Scholarship recipients are expected to correspond with their benefactors at least twice a year.</p>	Part relief of fees
Rural Scholarship	New applicant or existing resident from a rural or remote community	<p>The criteria for a successful application include sound academic performance, positive contributions (or the potential to contribute) to the collegiate community, service to the community at large and financial need.</p> <p>The scholarship may be renewable on the student continuing to achieve at a high level and making a positive contribution to the life of the College.</p>	Part relief of fees
Graham Thomson Scholarship	Brisbane Boys' College (BBC) student who is a new applicant to Emmanuel or a former BBC student who is an existing resident	<p>The scholarship was established in 2017 by BBC Old Boys John Wylie AM and Michael Wood to acknowledge Graham Thomson's longstanding service to education and the community, and pays tribute to his significant leadership, student mentoring and personal generosity.</p> <p>more information</p>	Part relief of fees
